We teach based on ***Project Approach***.

Children have a strong disposition to explore and discover. The Project Approach builds on natural curiosity, enabling children to interact, question, connect, problem-solve, communicate, reflect, and more. This kind of authentic learning extends beyond the classroom to each student's home, community, nation, and the world. It essentially makes learning the stuff of real life and children active participants in and shapers of their worlds.

We assess with a ***Portfolio System***.

If we desire to gain a true understanding of student growth toward developmental outcomes, then an authentic, ongoing process is needed. Formative assessment supports and informs instruction while learning is happening. Assessments happen during play and observation. Authentic work such as handwriting samples, self-portraits, interviews, cutting samples, and anecdotal notes for behavior/social/emotional and spiritual development are completed each month. Observations include note-taking, photos, and encouraging conversations that all align with early learning standards and domains. Teachers put assessment into their daily lesson plans throughout the day. Portfolios are available to view any time, and are shared with parents during parent teacher conferences in October and April.

We learn even more in our ***Outdoor Classroom***

All children need and benefit from more time outdoors. This benefit affects development and learning. It is critical for physical health. For children ages 0 to 5, development and learning outdoors is often easier and more beneficial than it is indoors. The outdoor learning program promotes a healthy lifestyle for young children and creates a respect for the earth they will inherit while providing inviting spots for play and learning. The Outdoor Classroom supports physical, social and emotional growth, as well as growth in math, science,

Early Childhood Summer Camp



One In Christ Religion Curriculum—Introducing lessons from the Old and New Testaments with stories, songs, finger plays, and action poems.

Heggerty Phonemic Awareness Program—introducing sounds of spoken language. Daily lessons are auditory activities involving students in manipulating sounds in words.

Second Step Social/Emotional Curriculum— Weekly lessons designed to teach learning skills, empathy, emotional management, friendship skills and problem solving. Work is done through stories, puppets, songs and games.
