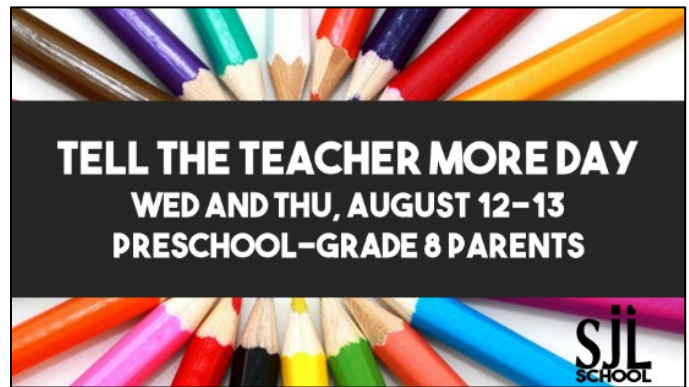


TELL THE TEACHER MORE DAY

After many months away from campus, this special visit will allow parents and children to meet the teacher and see the new classroom for the upcoming school year!



TELL THE TEACHER MORE DAY (TTM) visits will also replace our annual Back-to-School Night for K-8 children and families. Rather than bringing large groups of families on campus for orientation, the TTM visits will allow for each family to meet with the teacher individually for a specified time in the classroom.

WHAT IS TELL THE TEACHER MORE DAY?

This is for parents and children. Parents will meet the teacher in the classroom and share information about their child. Teachers will answer parent questions and share class procedures and expectations. Once the TTM or "private" conversations are over, the teacher will meet with your child for a classroom visit.

The TTM visit is scheduled for a 30-minute period. To help us make this a productive time for all, please complete the TTM questions (see page 2) in advance and give the form to the teacher for future reference.

You can sign up online for an appointment time with your child's teacher at www.wejoinin.com/SJLS. Select the best day and time to meet with the teacher.

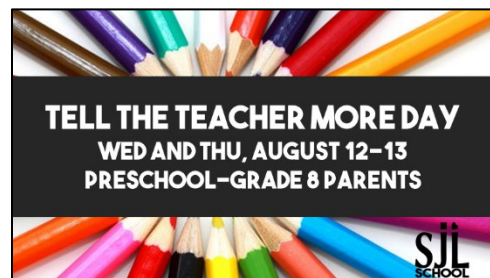
