Principally Speaking

Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good. His love endures forever. Psalm 136:1

The words from Psalm 136:1 have been used as a common meal prayer for years. And those words are often used during the month of "Thanksgiving".

During November, we are often reminded to give thanks to God for food and much more. In the Lord's Prayer, we pray for "daily bread". From Luther's Small Catechism, we learn that daily bread involves much more than food.

Gives us this day our daily bread.

What does this mean? All that we have in earthly things is a gift of God. He gives without our asking. He gives to all people. The difference between the Christian and non-Christian is this: Though both receive good things from God, the Christian acknowledges the gift as coming from God, whereas the non-Christian does not. We pray that God would lead us to realize His gifts to us and to receive our daily bread with thanksgiving.



What is meant by daily bread? Daily bread includes everything we need: food, shelter, clothing, family, happy home, peace, good weather, and all other blessings.

Why do we pray for "daily" bread? These words teach us not to be greedy or wasteful or to worry about the future but to live contentedly in the confidence that the Lord will give us what we need. We don't need to be anxious or fret about the future because God will provide each day.

As you celebrate Thanksgiving this month, make sure to not only give thanks for the many "things" that God has graciously bestowed upon us, but most importantly, give thanks to God for giving us His Son, Jesus, to die for us so that we may have the gift of eternal life.

Oh, give thanks ... for He is good!

School Entry Project

Our school entry project continues; we expect completion in mid-November. This project will provide better entry shelter during inclement weather and greater visibility for the main school entrance.

Thanks for your cooperation and understanding as we continue utilizing temporary parking, traffic, and school entry procedures.



Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures

With the new school entry to open soon, we will return to our "normal" drop off and pick up procedures at the main entry ... with a few changes.

Children and parents will enter and exit school through the main entrance ... for drive thru and walking children to/from parked cars (as in past years).

Morning drive thru drop off and afternoon drive thru pick up will be in the driveway between the church and school (as in past years).

Parents may park in both Jeffco Blvd and Church Rd parking lots and walk children to/from school and parked cars; children may not cross traffic lanes without parent supervision.



We will restrict some of the parking spaces between the church and school during morning

drop off and afternoon pickup times. This will allow for safer pedestrian traffic to/from the school main entry and parked cars.


