
Principally Speaking

The Lenten Season

The season of Lent began on Ash Wednesday (February 26) and is a 40-day period for self-examination and reflection as redeemed children of God. This time is one of sorrow,

grief, sadness, and repentance as we recount the story of the Passion of Jesus Christ ... culminating in His death by crucifixion. During Lent we recognize our sinful nature and deservedly accept God's judgment and punishment.
