MISSOURI'S 529 SAVINGS PLAN

Parents in Missouri can get a state tax deduction for K-12 private school tuition, thanks to the federal tax overhaul passed in December 2017. Missouri taxpayers can use MOST 529 assets to pay for K-12 tuition up to \$10,000 per year per student without state tax consequences. Earnings in 529 accounts are not subject to federal income tax, so long as funds are spent on qualified expenses.

Just about anybody can open a 529 account — parents, grandparents, other relatives, and friends. For info on MOST 529 plans or to open an account, go to www.missourimost.org or check with your financial planner.


School Closing: Weather
